SEED GROWN ANNUALS 3.5" POTS, 18/FLAT

Alyssum - Easter Bonnet Series

Very compact clumps of foliage covered with numerous reddish purple, white or pink fragrant flowers from spring through early fall. With its lovely honey fragrance, this delicate annual is an excellent choice for borders and containers.

Coleus - Versa Series

Happy in any light from full sun to deep shade! Go-anywhere beauty that intensifies as the weather warms up. A compact and very lush plant that is late to bloom for easy care and maintenance.

Dianthus - Ideal Series

Achillea - Moonshine

Upright, clump-forming, compact hybrid yarrow with fern-like, aromatic, silvery to gray-green foliage and bright lemon-yellow flowers.

Achillea - Cerise Queen

Shell pink to deep cherry red flowers on strong stems. Makes a great cut flower. Blooms June through late summer

Achillea - Summer Berries

A sumptuous mix of fruity colors. Attracts bees and butterflies. Use cut flowers fresh or dried.

PERENNIALS (continued)

Achillea - Terra Cotta

Multicolored effect! Shades of yellow, peach, orange and reds give wow power! Silver-green fern like foliage.

Alyssum - Mountain Gold

Low growing groundcover that is excellent for rock gardens. Plant in full sun in fertile well drained soil.

Aquilegia - Colorado Violet White

This showy columbine produces lots of large, violet-black and white flowers in late spring.

Aquilegia - Leprechaun Gold

Attractive gold and green marbled leaves, large violet blooms held high above the foliage.

Aquilegia - Lime Sorbet

Lime-green to white double pom-pom flowers that are without spurs.

Aquilegia - McKana's Giants

Extra large blooms! The flowers either face outward or are nodding. Wide range of colors.

Arabis - Snow Cap

Early bloomer, small bright white flowers, uniform mounding habit.

Arabis - Spring Charm

Sweetly scented. Abundant rose pink blooms over attractive ever-green foliage. Good for edging or around shrubs and hedges.

Arenaria - Montana

Vigorous, low-growing evergreen groundcover, Cup shaped white flowers, dark green leaves. .

Armeria - Armada Alba

Neat tufts of grasslike foliage with bright flower globes on wiry stems. Excellent for the front of a border.

Armeria - Pride of Dusseldorf

Neat, evergreen tufts of grass-like foliage, deep ruby pink flowers.

Armeria - rubrifolia

Chive-like flowers are held several inches above the tight, dark burgundy foliage.

Armeria - Splendens

A great groundcover and rock garden plant. Dense pink flower heads rise above mounds of green grasslike leaves.

Aubrieta - Cascade Blue

Beautiful double blue flowers on clean, green foliage with a lovely dome forming habit.

Aubrieta - Cascade Red

A gorgeous spring-flowering groundcover. Prolific 3/4" blooms.

Bellis - Habanera Mix

Large quilled double flowers on compact plants.

Bellis - Speedstar Mix

The best pomponette bellis available. Slightly larger than normal pom-pom types, on compact, short, strong stems that bud uniformly.

PERENNIALS (continued)

Bergenia cordifolia 'Winterglut'

Distinctive heart shaped leathery leaves are thick and glossy. Noted for its excellent ruby red fall and winter foliage. Pink flowers in spring, plus some fall rebloom.

Campanula cochlearifolia 'Bavarian Blue'

Sky blue miniature trumpets cascade down the waxy low growing foliage in a gorgeous carpet of color. Neat and carefree all summer.

Campanula cochlearifolia 'Bavarian White'

White miniature trumpets cascade down the waxy low growing foliage in a gorgeous carpet of color. Neat and carefree all summer.

Cheiranthus - Orange Bedder

Sweetly fragrant, rich orange flowers on dwarf, sturdy plants.

Coreopsis - Baby Sun

Prolific blooms of bright gold with a deep maroon ring in the center. Drought resistant, very easy to grow.

Coreopsis grandiflora 'Early Sunrise'

Golden yellow, semi-double flowers on 20" stems from early summer into fall.

Crocosmia x crocosmiiflora 'Emily McKenzie'

Add a blast of late summer heat to your garden! Bright burnt orange blooms with contrasting mahogany eyes.

Crocosmia - George Davidson

This is the best golden yellow crocosmia for size and number of blossoms.

Delphinium - Guardian Early Blue

Incredible beautiful blue blooms that are very early and extremely uniform. Great in the garden or as a cut flower.

Delphinium - Magic Fountains Mix

2 feet tall and a rainbow of color! A mix of violet, lilac, lavender, rose, cream and blue.

Delphinium - Pacific Giants Mix

Statuesque and spectacular in color. The tall, large blossoms appear in colors of pink, violet and many shades of blue.

Delphinium - Summer Skies

Immense, graceful light to medium blue spikes with white "bees".

Delphinium - Summer Stars

Dwarf. Elegant, white star shaped flowers on finely-dissected foliage.

Dianthus - Tiny Rubies

Sweetly clove-scented, bright ruby-pink flowers have a velvety or satiny sheen.

Dianthus gratianopolitanus 'Wicked Witch'

Deep cherry red flowers rise above dense, grayish green foliage.

Dianthus deltoides 'Zing Rose'

Mat-forming plants with bright rose-red flowers that will bloom all summer. Prefers partial shade.

Digitalis - Camelot White and Camelot Rose

3-4' tall flower stalks will be laden with beautiful tubular flowers that have speckled throats.

PERENNIALS (continued)

Digitalis - Foxy

Showy spikes of large, bell shaped flowers of pink, yellow and white shades.

Digitalis - Sahara

Unusual yellow flowers with bronzy-orange throats. Lance shaped leaves are finely cut. A sturdy, somewhat shorter variety. Biennial.

Doronicum orientale 'Little Leo'

Delivers an abundance of cheerful, semi-double, daisy like, bright-yellow flowers for early spring gardens. Cool season bloomer.

Echinacea purpurea 'Magnus'

Previous Perennial Plant of the Year Winner! Large rosy-purple blooms with a dark rose center. Petals don't droop as much as standard varieties.

Erysimum hybridum 'Apricot Twist'

Spicy fragrance. Clusters of bright apricot flowers atop dark green-silver foliage that has a compact upright habit.

Erysimum hybridum 'Fragrant Sunshine'

Spicy fragrance. Bright yellow bloom atop atop dark green foliage with a silver sheen. Compact, bush-like plant.

Erysimum - Pastel Patchwork

Mounds of evergreen foliage resplendent in exquisitely fragrant blooms. Use in fresh cut or dried arrangements.

Gallardia aristata 'Arizona Sun'

Bright red flowers with golden tip and grayish green foliage. Compact and long blooming. Attracts butterflies, birds and bees.

Gallardia x grandiflora Mesa Yellow

Upward-facing ray flowers; petals are brilliant scarlet trumpets that flare to bright yellow at the ends. Blooms almost year-round.

Gaura lindheimeri Passionate Rainbow

Striking blush pink flowers and dark foliage on upright "airy plants. Blooms from late spring until autumn.

Gaura lindheimeri Sunset Dream Pink

Striking rose pink flowers and dark foliage on a more compact plant. Blooms from late spring until autumn.

Heuchera - Harvest Burgundy

Dark, slightly marbled foliage. Plant in part sun to part shade. Cool weather performer.

Heuchera - Lemon Chiffon

Outstanding yellow to chartreuse foliage that thrives under shorter days and cooler temperatures of autumn.

Heuchera micrantha Palace Purple

Compact plant with striking deep purple-red leaves and stems and sprays of small white flowers.

Heuchera - Pistache

Large, light lime green to chartreuse yellow leaves. Stems of cream, bell-shaped flowers rise above the foliage.

Heuchera - Ruby Bells

Dense mounds of rounded green foliage and elongated stems with small, brilliant red flowers for a long period in early summer.

PERENNIALS (Continued)

Heuchera - Swirling Fantasy

Pewter red foliage with dark veins and bright red flowers. The only purple heuchera plant with red flowers.

Hosta - Earth Angel

Large! Heart-shaped, blue-green leaves with wide, creamy-white margins. Pale lavender flowers appear in midsummer.

Hosta - Katsuragawa Beni

Narrow, shiny green leaves with pointed tips. Crimson petioles and spotting half way up the leaves. Lavender flowers midsummer.

Hosta - Sieboldiana Blue Angel

Large! Leaves are heavily corrugated deep blue-green color. Near-white flowers open in very dense clusters in late June to late July.

Hosta - Sieboldiana Thunderbolt

Heavily corrugated leaves have wide blue-green margins with a narrow creamy-yellow center. Vigorous grower! White flowers.

Hosta - Sleeping Beauty

Pointed frosty blue-green leaves set off by a lovely cream margin. Pale lavender flowers.

Hosta - Sum and Substance

Large! Chartreuse leaves turn to medium gold as the season progresses. Lavender flowers in late August.

Hosta - Twilight

Thick, dark green leaves with wide, light, golden yellow margins. Lightly corrugated, broadly ovate leaves. Lavender flowers.

Iberis sempervirens Purity

Low, glossy evergreen mounds covered with masses of fragrant, bright white flowers in mid-spring.

Leucanthemum x superbum Aglaia

The frilliest, fluffiest Shasta Daisy noted for prolific flowering, large white blooms with yellow centers.

Leucanthemum x superbum Alaska

Deep green foliage and strong stems produce very free-flowering, single, pure white blooms with yellow centers.

Leucanthemum - Ice Star

Long-lasting, white, double flowers on mounded plants. Makes a great cut flower and attracts butterflies.

Leucanthemum x superbum 'Silver Princess'

Single white flowers with yellow centers on plants that have a dwarf bushy habit.

Leucanthemum - White Knight

A myriad of large, four inch white daisies with yellow centers in mid to late June. Compact plants with strong stems for cutting.

Lithodora diffusa Grace Ward

Azure blue flowers on a dark green mat of hardy, evergreen, creeping ground cover.

Lobelia - Compliment Red

The bronze foliage of this plant has alternate leaves that complement the brilliant red flowers. Tall variety, 3-5 ft. garden height.

PERENNIALS (Continued)

Lobelia fulgens Elm Fire

Butterfly-shaped, bright crimson blooms, smoky-dark, charcoal-bronze foliage/stems. Late season bloomer, attracts Hummingbirds.

Lupine polyphyllus - 'Gallery Series'

Green, finger-like leaflets make up this dwarf variety. Spikes of blooms solid and bicolor patterns. Sold in individual colors and mix: blue, pink, red, white and yellow

Myosotis sylvatica - 'Mon Amie Blue'

An excellent compact plant with small mid-blue flowers. Ideal in early spring borders for a traditional look.

Papaver Iceland nudicaule - 'Champagne Bubbles'

Gray-green, lobed foliage grows below an array of silky blooms of orange, pink, white or yellow.

Papaver orientale - 'Allegro'

Compact Oriental poppy with great garden performance. Classic, big silky, orange-scarlet blooms.

Papaver orientale - 'Beauty of Livermore'

BIG, bright, beautiful, oxblood-red flower has crepe-like petals with a dark eye. Deer resistant.

Papaver orientale - 'Brilliant'

Fiery red, crepe-like flowers with dark eyes, plants with bristly stems and slightly hairy leaves that adds great texture to the garden.

Papaver orientale Pizzacato Mix

Fleuroselect Gold Medal Winner! Semi dwarf poppy, huge flowers in a wide range of colors

Papaver orientale Princess Victoria Louise

Luxurious, large salmon colored, satiny blooms with a large purple-black eye.

Penstemon - Margarita

Green foliage with an upright habit that supports multiple spikes of sky blue flowers that fade to purple. Long blooming

Penstemon - Sunburst Ruby

Naturally compact, bushy habit. Large, ruby red blossoms with bright white throat. Summer bloomer.

Penstemon - Midnight Blue

Showy, long-blooming spikes of tubular, Deep violet flowers rise above rosettes of narrow foliage.

Phlox subulata 'Candy Stripe'

An ideal groundcover with masses of tiny white flowers with a pink mid-stripe and a thick mat of semi-evergreen foliage.

Phlox subulata Crimson Beauty

Masses of rose-pink, star shaped flowers, above evergreen, spreading mats of needle like, mid green foliage.

Phlox - Drummons Pink

Lightly fragrant. A multiple use showy pink phlox with notched flower tips.

Phlox subulata 'Emerald Blue'

Lavender blue flowers bloom in early spring on this groundcover that will thrive in a sunny spot with well-drained soil.

PERENNIALS (Continued)

Rudbeckia hirta Goldstrum

(Blackeyed Susan) Long lasting, large, dark yellow daisy-like flowers with a black center cone are produced in abundance.

Rudbeckia gloriosa Irish Eyes

Long lasting, large, single golden daisy-like flowers with a emerald-green cone. Great for cut flowers.

Salvia - May Night

Deep blue summer long blooms. Deer resistant, butterfly attractent.

Salvia x superba Merleau

Long summer bloomer! Erect, compact, clump-forming habit with dense spikes of purplish-blue flowers on 16" stems.

Salvia superba Select

Dwarf salvia, naturally flowering mid summer through autumn with a well branched habit. In deep violet blue and rose.

Scabiosa - Butterfly Blue

Compact habit with gray-green leaves and a long bloom period featuring pretty lavender-blue flowers.

Scabiosa - Pink Mist

Compact and very well matched to Butterfly Blue with soft pink fully double blooms.

Sedum - Autumn Joy

Flowers late summer into fall. Blooms start light pink, slowly turning to red and later in fall to a deeper rusty-red. Succulent leaves.

Sedum - Mediovariegatum

Succulent, green leaves with splashes of creamy white to pale yellow markings. Large clusters of star-shaped, white to pale pink flowers.

Sedum - Mini Joy

A compact version of Autumn joy. Salmon pink flowers, blooms late summer into fall.

Sedum - Purple Emperor

Rich purple-black leaves offer color interest earlier in the season, then a colorful display of dusty rose flowers follow in the fall.

Stachys - byzantina (Lamb's Ears)

Drought tolerant and deer resistant. Soft fuzzy silver foliage. An excellent choice for the rock garden.

Verbena - Homestead Purple

Large, fragrant bright purple flowers. Ruffly deep green leaves form a twisty, trailing clump.

Veronica peduncularis Georgia Blue

A semi-prostrate, spreading plant featuring spires of tiny, round, blue flowers which bloom late April-May.

Veronica spicata Red Fox

Bushy plant which features dense, upright spikes of tiny, deep rose-red flowers Makes a good cut flower. Summer bloom.

Viola - labridorica

Slowly spreading groundcover with purple-tinged leaves Tiny blue-violet flowers appear in spring.
